CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY RULES, REGULATIONS AND

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The applicant must be a United States citizen who will enroll in an accredited college or university in the United States.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduating High School Senior, residing in the Greater New Haven area, and enrolled in an accredited Greater New Haven area high school.
- 3. Special consideration will be given to current members of the NAACP (Membership must be verified by providing a copy of the Membership Card or receipt showing Membership Payment).
- 4. The applicant must possess an un-weighted grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- 5. Students applying for the SCSU scholarship must provide proof of acceptance from SCSU.
- 6. Failure to adhere to the stated rules and regulations will disqualify applicant.
- 7. Scholarship awards will be forwarded to the college or university to which the winners have matriculated. THE APPLICATION PROCESS WILL REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:
- THE APPLICATION PROCESS WILL REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:
- Application Form
- •Official or unofficial high school transcript, SAT/ACT Scores, and a report card of the 1stand 2nd 2016- 2017 marking periods.
- Copy of the college acceptance letter to which the applicant will matriculate.
- •Copy of NAACP membership card or payment receipt, applicable if applicant and/or applicant's parent(s) is a member.
- Typed essay.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. All applications and accompanying documentation must be postmarked by April 7, 2017.
